



## French Courses for Immigrants Summer 2011

Upgrade your skills in Canada's other official language by registering **free of charge** in French language courses offered by the Collège universitaire de Saint-Boniface.

### Eligibility requirements

- Have some prior knowledge of French (**Beginner 3 and over**).
- Complete the eligibility form and submit proof of immigrant or permanent resident status.

Also taken into consideration depending on the number of applicants and spaces available:

- Letters from employers or employment counsellors recommending the knowledge of French for employment. To be submitted with the eligibility form.
- Recent date of entry into Canada.

### Course details

- Each course consists of 32.5 or 33 hours of instruction.
- If an applicant admitted into the program is absent without justification the first day of classes, his or her spot could be given to another person on the waiting list.
- Learner attendance and achievement reports are sent to the Adult Language Training Branch.

### Registration

- Apply to the Continuing Education Division in the program of your choice:
  - *Français oral*
- The summer session begins July 11, 2011.  
**The deadline for registration is June 17, 2011.**
- Forms are available at the offices of the Continuing Education Division, room 1411, CUSB, and online at <http://dep.cusb.ca>.
- Students may be limited to four sessions of instruction within the French Courses for Immigrants Program.
